WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 the Budha Siksha Seva Sansthan, C/o - Sant Gandhi Residential High School, Shekhpura, Patna, Bihar-800014 has submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting E.T.E. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) students.

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution / society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the Elementary Teacher Education Programme (E.T.E.) such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory, etc. for running the programme and has selected / appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.

3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Eastern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Budha Siksha Seva Sansthan, C/o - Sant Gandhi Residential High School, Shekhpura, Patna, Bihar-800014 for conducting E.T.E. Course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 (fifty) students with effect from issue of this order. The institution shall ensure the fulfillment of the following:-

- The institution will ensure that the teaching faculty (1(one) Principal +5 (five) teachers) members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 50 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Eastern Regional Committee before the commencement of the course, and information be put up in the institution website as per NCTE regulation 2005, notified in Gazette of India dated 13th January, 2006:
- The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by concerned State Govt.

- c) The institution shall obtain affiliation from the examining body before the commencement of the course.
 - d) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Eastern Regional Committee.
 - e) The Reserve Fund for an amount of Rs. 3.00 lakh be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the management/ institution.
 - f) The institution shall maintain and update their website as per NCTE regulations.
 - g) The intake, eligibility and admission procedure shall be strictly adhered as per NCTE norms.
 - h) Performance Appraisal Report shall be submitted by the end of every academic year on the prescribed format.
 - i) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory body like the State Government, wherever applicable.
5. The institution shall submit to the Eastern Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Eastern Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
